Lacombe Regional Waste Services Commission (LRWSC) has a **Permanent full-time** opportunity for a **Transfer Station Operator** to join our team at the Prentiss Transfer Site, working Monday to Friday, from 9am- 5pm. The successful candidate will join a team dedicated to the growth and success of LRWSC.

The Transfer Station Site Operator is responsible for:

- ♦ assisting, directing and educating customers in proper waste disposal methods;
- ♦ managing the burn pit and changing out the bins;
- ♦ recycling mattresses;
- ♦ maintaining the cleanliness of the site;
- ♦ conducting visual inspections of loads as needed to prevent disposal of prohibited materials;
- ♦ performing minor preventative maintenance duties, such as greasing and oiling;
- ♦ operating the scales to properly weigh vehicles etc;
- ♦ participating in workplace safety initiatives and meetings, and reporting to work fit for duty.

We're looking for an individual:

- ♦ who has the ability to communicate effectively with facility users to assure proper usage and provide assistance as required;
- ♦ who enjoys working outdoors in various weather conditions and is able to perform medium lifting and moving of objects of up to 40lbs;
- ♦ enjoys performing a variety of tasks (mowing grass, shoveling snow, assisting customers) and helping out co-workers when required (operating skid steer/tractor, changing out bins, etc.);
- ♦ who is dependable and is able to work with minimal supervision;
- ♦ who has a minimum of a valid Class 3 Alberta Driver's License. Equipment operation experience is preferred.
