Lacombe Regional Waste Services Commission has a **permanent part-time** opportunity for a **Transfer Station Operator to** join our team at the Prentiss Transfer Site, working Saturday, Monday and Tuesday, from 9am - 5pm (24 hours per week).

The Transfer Station Site Operator is responsible for:

- assisting, directing and educating customers in proper waste disposal methods;
- managing the burn pit and changing out the bins;
- maintaining the cleanliness of the site;
- conducting visual inspections of loads as needed to prevent disposal of prohibited materials;
- performing minor preventative maintenance duties, such as greasing and oiling;
- participating in workplace safety initiatives and meetings, and reporting to work fit for duty;
- operating the scales to properly weight vehicles, etc;

We're looking for an individual:

- who has the ability to communicate effectively with facility users to assure proper usage and provide assistance as required;
- who enjoys working outdoors in various weather conditions and is able to perform medium lifting and moving of objects of up to 40lbs;
- enjoys performing a variety of tasks (mowing grass, shoveling snow, assisting customers) and helping out co-workers when required (operating skid steer/tractor, changing out bins, etc.)
